- -Recognize and value the diversity of people in our region and understand that I may encounter perspectives and beliefs that are different from my own. I will approach these differences with curiosity and engage in conversations from a place of genuine interest and willingness to grow.
- -Recognize that our shared vision for a regenerative mutual aid support system in Western North Carolina is a long-term goal and focus on positive actions to achieve this shared vision, including providing constructive feedback.
- -Practice consent culture and not engage with physical touch or closeness unless expressly desired by another community member.
- -Contribute to the network within my reasonable capacity and remain engaged. Engagement can take many forms; attending events, posting on the Facebook group, opening the newsletters, contributing feedback and ideas, responding to mutual aid requests, etc.
- -Participate fully and proactively in addressing any conflicts that arise that I am involved in to determine restorative actions that meet the needs of everyone involved.
- -Pay membership fees and costs for any other events or services, promptly and fully. This includes proactively updating payment methods to current and functional accounts.
